Transportation

Free shuttle buses will be offered for pick-up and drop-off to and from the event:

Shuttle 1: departs **Regeneration Outreach Community** at 12:30pm (156 Main St. N, Brampton, Grace Place parking lot), stops on the way at **Moyo Health & Community Services** (7700 Hurontario St., Brampton, parking lot next to Dollarama).

Shuttle 2: departs **Kipling TTC Station** at 12:30pm (Kipling Passenger Pick-up and Dropoff area), stops on the way at **Dundas St W and Hurontario St** (parking lot at southwest corner, by RBC), then **University of Toronto Mississauga** (1867 Inner Circle Rd., near William G. Davis building).

All shuttle buses will leave Huron Park Community Centre at 4:30pm, following the same routes to return.
